2 AXIS PTZ CONTROL – FUNCTIONAL OVERVIEW

AXIS camera PTZ control. Control your AXIS camera based on KNX®, EnOcean and IP.

- Stepwise Pan Tilt Direction Control
- Absolute pan position by value range
 - \rightarrow -180" to 180°.
- 0% to 100% (automatic conversion and thus optimal for the use of slider elements)
- Step-by-step pan movement with freely selectable step widths in degrees
- Absolute tilt position by value range
 - > -180" to 180°.
- 0% to 100% (automatic conversion and thus optimal for the use of slider elements)
- Stepwise tilt movement with freely selectable step sizes in degrees
- Absolute zoom by value range
 - > -180" to 180°.
- 0% to 100% (automatic conversion and thus optimal for the use of slider elements)
- Step-by-step zoom with freely selectable step widths
- Automatic determination of the value range for pan, tilt and zoom

Product variants:

The APPMODULE is available in three variants:

- **APP**MODULE KNX/TP for stand-alone use on KNX/TP Bus
- APPMODULE EnOcean for stand-alone use in the EnOcean wireless network
- APPMODULE IP for use in an IP-based KNX installation (KNXnet/IP) or as extension for an EIBPORT

4 APP INSTALLATION / UPDATE

Please proceed as follows to install an App.

- 1. Open the APPMODULE web page: Enter <IP Address of APPMODULE> into your browser's address bar and press Enter. The APPMODULE web interface will appear.
- 2. Log in with your user credentials. Please refer to the APPMODULE documentation for login details.
- 3. Click on the menu entry "App Manager"
- 4. You are now on the page where already installed Apps are listed. The list will be empty if no apps have been installed. Click "Install App" in order to install a new app.
- 5. Now click on "Select App"; a file selector window will appear. Choose the app » **AXIS PTZ Control** « and click "OK". The Smart Home App » **AXIS PTZ Control** « must first be downloaded from the BAB APP MARKET (www.bab-appmarket.de).
- 6. After the message "Installation successful" appears, click "OK". You are ready to configure the App.
- 7. To update an already installed app, click on the App icon in the "App Manager".
- 8. The detail view of the App appears. Click on "Update App" to select the app package and start the update. The update version must be downloaded from the BAB APP MARKET.

After the message "Installation successful" appears, click "OK". The app has been updated. Your instance configurations will remain unchanged.

5 APP SETTINGS

AXIS camera PTZ control.

5.1 INSTANCE

As soon as the app is installed, you can create so called "Instance". An Instance is one of several objects of the same class.

In order to create an instance, click on the symbol "Create Instance".

Instance Name:

Choose a name for this new instance.

Comment:

Insert a description what this instance does.

5.2 CONNECTION PARAMETERS

IP Address:

Enter the IP address of the camera you want to control.

Accept any SSL certificate:

If your camera has a valid domain and custom SSL certificate you can disable this checkbox and enforce a more strict certificate check.

Username:

Enter the username for PTZ control

Password:

Enter the password for PTZ control

5.3 MOVE

Up/Down:

Enter the group address to move your camera up and down (1: up, 0: down).

Right/Left:

Enter the group address to move your camera to the right or left (1: right, 0: left).



5.4 PAN

Absolute Pan:

Enter the group address for absolute pan with an integer. The supported value range is usually - 180...180°.

Absolute Pan:

Enter the group address for absolute pan in percent. The app will retrieve the pan range from your camera and automatically scale 0...100% accordingly.

Relative Pan:

Enter the group address to configure relative panning (1: pan right, 0: pan outleft) with the given step width.

Relative Pan Step Width:

Enter a value between 1 and 360° which represents the absolute step width for each pan command. The default value is 30°.

5.5 TILT

Absolute Tilt:

Enter the group address for absolute tilt with an integer. The supported value range is usually - 180...180°.

Absolute Tilt:

Enter the group address for absolute tilt in percent. The app will retrieve the supported tilt range from your camera and automatically scale 0...100% accordingly.

Relative Tilt:

Enter the group address to configure relative tilting (1: tilt right 0: tilt left) with the given step width.

Relative Tilt Step Width:

Enter a value between 1 and 360° which represents the absolute step width for each tilt command. The default value is 30°.

5.6 **ZOOM**

Absolute Zoom:

Enter the group address for absolute zoom with an integer. Cameras without digital zoom have a zoom range of about 10,000, camera with digital zoom up to 20,000.

Absolute Zoom:

Enter the group address for absolute zoom in percent. The app will retrieve the supported zoom range from your camera and automatically scale 0...100% accordingly.

Relative Zoom in/out:

Enter the group address for relative zoom in and out (1: zoom in, 0: zoom out) with the given step width.

Relative Zoom Step Width:

Enter an integer value which represents the absolute step width for each zoom command. Cameras without digital zoom have a zoom range of about 10,000, camera with digital zoom up to 20,000. The default of 1,000 represents 10 or 5% of that range.

5.7 BRIGHTNESS

Relative Brightness:

Enter the group address to adjust brightness relatively (1: brighter, 0: darker).

Relative Brightness Step Width:

Enter a value between 1 and 9999 which represents the absolute step width for each dim command. The default value is 1000.

Backlight Compensation On/Off:

Enter the group address to turn the backlight compensation on or off

5.8 PRESETS:

Preset Number:

Enter the group address for the preset number. A telegram with value x will load the camera preset number x.
